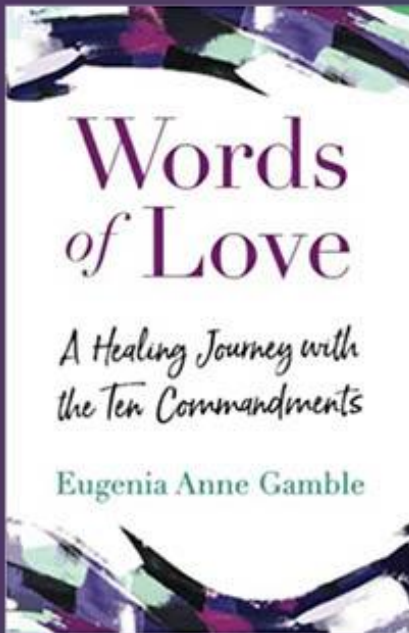

## ADULT EDUCATION BOOK DISCUSSION

For many years Rev. Eugenia Anne Gamble taught retreats and classes on the Ten Commandments. The results of her many interactions with people and of her study is the book, *Words of Love: A Healing Journey with the Ten Commandments*.

Please join us as we read and discuss the book this summer. Rev. Anne will lead as we dive into each of the commandments with the author and find that they are more than a list of ancient rules. Readers will discover that the Ten Commandments are words from the heart of God, given to reconcile creation to Creator and God's people to one another. # Authors of St. Andrews

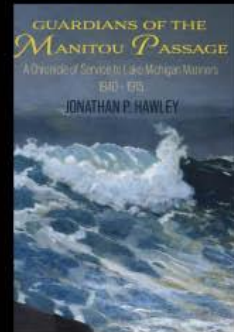

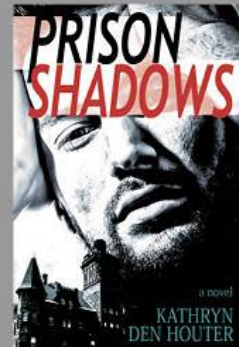

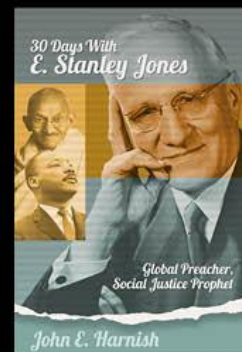
