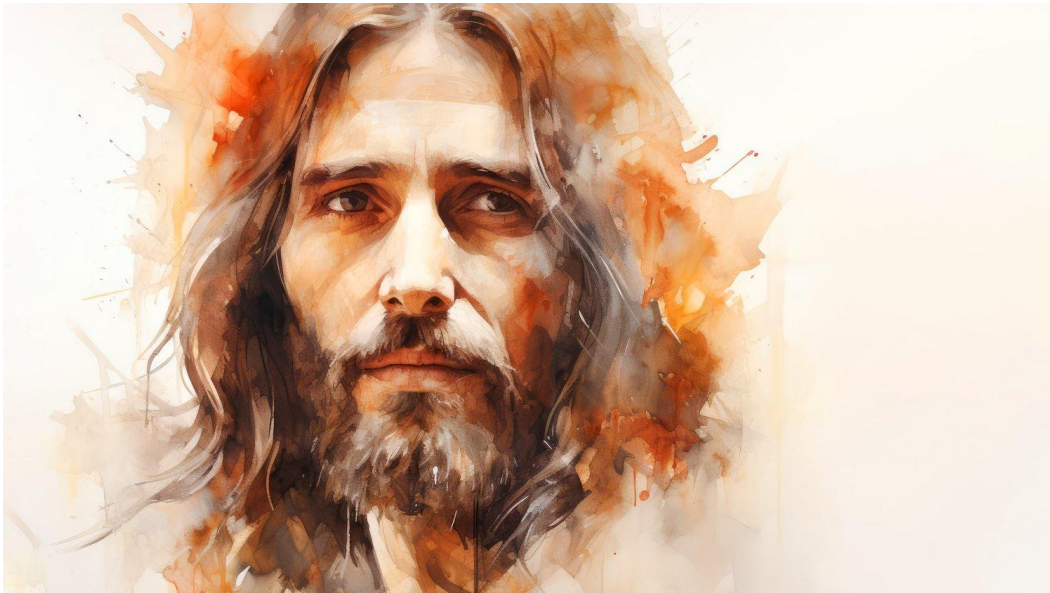

*CONFESSION AND PARDON

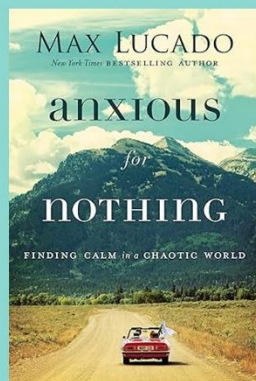
